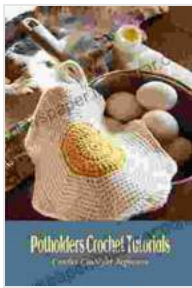

Tips for Crocheting Potholders

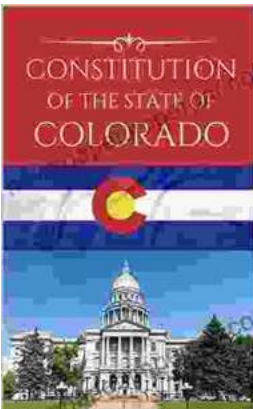

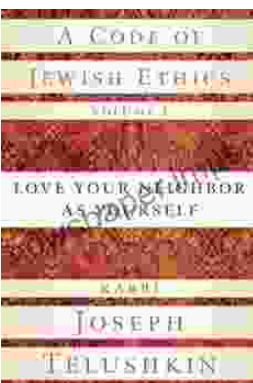
